Like most other websites, we use cookies on www.neonlabs.org. You should carefully read this Cookies Policy (the “**Cookies Policy**”) with due advance. By using, accessing or registering on the Service (as this term defined below) in any manner, including but not limited to visiting or browsing this Website, you agree to be bound by this Cookie Policy and all other operating rules, policies and procedures (changes, amendments, alterations thereto) that may be published from time to time on this Website.

This Cookies Policy tells you more about cookies and other similar tracking technologies that we apply when you visit or use the Website and the choice you have. This Cookie Policy should be read in conjunction with the Privacy Policy. This Cookies Policy explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control or use of them.

1. INTRODUCTION

1. This Cookies Policy determines the way we process the cookie from users of www.neonlabs.org (the “**Website**”), applications, materials, other content, services and products provided (directly/indirectly) by the Company, as well as the devices to contact the Company (the “**Service**”) and/or our counterparties (“**users**”, “**you**”, “**your**”).
2. The Services are operated by Neon Labs Ltd., a legal entity incorporated and existing in accordance with Cayman Islands legislation (the “**Company**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”). The Service may contain links to third-party websites, apps, utilities, etc. (not operated by the Company) to exit the Service. The Company cannot accept liability for the process of cookie by such third parties.
3. This Cookie Policy does not apply to utilities which can be offered on other services (devices, apps, portals, websites) not operated by the Company.
4. We may process cookies as long as users give us a legitimate consent for that in accordance with applicable legislation.
5. Hereby you irrevocably declare:
 - 5.1. that you have read, understood, found satisfactory and fully accepted this Cookie Policy and the Terms of Use;
 - 5.2. that you confirm that your affirmative consent for processing of cookie is given freely, clearly, specifically and unambiguously;
 - 5.3. that you consider the Terms of Use and risk warnings and risk disclosures provided in the Website in any form as an integral part of this Cookie Policy.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES AND WHY ARE COOKIES USED

- 2.1. Cookie files are small pieces of data (often text files) which are designed to identify a browser on computers, phones and other devices connected to the Internet and automatically downloaded on your device when you visit the Website. As a standard feature of major browser applications, cookies are widely used to make online services work or operate more efficiently, as well as to provide info to the providers of those online services about your browsing experiences. This, in particular, helps to identify you, analyse, improve and secure the Service and to personalize content and features and tailor and measure online advertisements or marketing emails, both on and off the Service.
- 2.2. The Company may place, view, and/or use cookies, Web server logs, Web beacons, or other electronic tools to collect statistical and other information about your use of the Website. This information may include information about the IP address of your computer, browser type, language, operating system, your device, geo-location data, the state or country from which you accessed this Website, the Web pages visited, the date and the time of a visit, the websites you visited immediately before and after visiting this Website, the number of links you click within this Website, the functions you use on this Website, the databases you view and the searches you request on this Website, the data you save on or download from this Website and the number of times you view an advertisement.
- 2.3. These technologies are used for:
 - (a) managing the security of the Website;
 - (b) collection of statistical and other data about your Website's usage;
 - (c) recognising when you log in and any preferred settings;
 - (d) improving the Website;
 - (e) improving Company's products and services;
 - (f) measuring the effectiveness of ads which give us insights about user behaviour so we can give you more user-friendly search experience; or

(g) giving you personalized experience as the user of the Website.

3. HOW TO CONTROL COOKIE FILES

- 3.1. You have further rights in relation to your cookies:
 - (a) to set web browser to refuse cookie files or to alert when cookie files are being sent;
 - (b) to decide whether to accept or reject cookie files. If you do so, you may still use the Website though your access to some functionality and areas of the Website may be restricted.
